In Gen 1:28 one might paraphrase it as follows: "harness its potential and use its resources for your benefit."</li> </ul>

Tension decreases: God endowed humankind (1:28) with ability (i.e. blessed) and created them as male and female (1:27). God provided food via green plants and fruit trees (1:29).	
Tension simmers: Will humankind populate and rule?
