## Deuteronomy 6:4-5 – God is One.

### A. God is one.

- 1. God is the only object of our worship.
- 2. God is unique. He is one of a kind.
- 3. God cannot be divided.

4	"Hear, O Israel: The LORD <mark>our</mark> God, the LORD [is] one.	<ul> <li>This is called the "Shema."</li> <li>NET: [1] sole object of worship; [2] unique, one of a kind</li> </ul>
5	And you shall love the LORD your God <ul> <li>with all your heart</li> <li>and with all your person</li> <li>and with all your strength.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>NET: To love the LORD is to be absolutely loyal and obedient to him in every respect.</li> <li>See Matthew 22:37-40.</li> </ul>

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## John 17:20-21 – The Father and the Son are One.

### A. The Father and the Son are one.

- 1. Our oneness as believers should reflect their oneness.
- 2. Our oneness as believers is the main factor in drawing non-believers into the faith.

20	<ul> <li>(x) I do not ask concerning these only,</li> <li>(y) but also concerning those who believe in me through their word,</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>These: disciples in the Upper Room</li> </ul>
21	<ul> <li>(a) in order that they may all be one,</li> <li>just as you, Father, [are] in me,</li> <li>and I [am] in you,</li> <li>(b) in order that they also may be in us,</li> </ul>	• They: those who believe in the Word from the apostles.
	(c) <b>in order that</b> the world may <b>believe</b> that you sent me.	

# Genesis 2:23-24 – The Goal of Marriage is Oneness.

### A. The goal of marriage is to become one with our spouse.

- 1. Adam joyfully received his handcrafted bride.
- 2. She was literally part of his flesh.

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23	Then the man said,	-
	"This at last	
	<ul> <li>is bone from my bones</li> </ul>	
	<ul> <li>and <b>flesh</b> from my <b>flesh</b>.</li> </ul>	
	She shall be <b>called</b> Woman,	
	because she <mark>was <b>taken</b> out</mark> of Man."	

- 3. We should prioritize our marriage over our relationship with our parents.
- 4. We should hold fast to, hold onto, cling to, and join together with our spouse...
  - For better or for worse...
  - For richer or for poorer...
  - In sickness and in health...
  - Until we are parted by death.
- 5. Our oneness should as a couple should reflect the oneness of the Father and the Son.

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#### B. Application for Marriage

- 1. Our marriage is one of a kind and unique. Our spouse is handcrafted to fill our gaps.
- 2. We should stand against anything that divides us.
- 3. Our marriage is our most important human relationship:
  - More important than our parents... though we must honor our parents.
  - More important than our children... though we must teach our children about God.
  - More important than our church... though we shouldn't neglect fellowship & worship.
  - More important than our ministry... though we must still make disciples.
  - More important than our work... though we must still provide for physical needs.
- 4. We should hold fast to our spouse through all circumstances.
- 5. Our oneness should reflect the oneness the Father, Son, and Spirit.
  - Oneness is unity, but not sameness.
  - The Father, Son, and Spirit are each distinct persons with distinct roles.
  - Yet each is of equal value. Each is truly God.
  - Celebrate your spouse's uniqueness.
- 6. People should see our marriage and want to become Christians.
